Upcoming Back Garden Works

Please note that from Monday 30th of May to Wednesday 1st June we will be digging out and relaying our back garden. During this time the main door will be shut and access for the babies and toddlers will be through the baby unit entrance and access for Caterpillars and Butterflies will be through the Caterpillars entrance.













Now that the Wet Spring weather is here, could you please ensure that your children have appropriate clothing for the garden and outdoor play. This may include jackets, wellies, hats, spare clothes, and/or all in one rain coats if necessary

We like to get the children out even in inclement weather and don't want anyone to miss out.

Could you also please ensure that you send in at least two changes of clothing for your little one including socks and underwear. We love to get the children involved in messy play and want to ensure they always have something warm and comfortable to change into afterwards if needed.

Lastly could any borrowed clothing please be returned to the nursery so that we have extras on hand should another child need them.

TAX Free Childcare

You can get up to £500 every 3 months (£2,000 a year) for each of your children to help with the costs of childcare.

If you get Tax-Free Childcare, the government will pay £2 for every £8 you pay your childcare provider. This is paid via an online childcare account that you set up for your child.

You can get Tax-Free Childcare at the same time as 30 hours free childcare if you're eligible for both. https://www.gov.uk/tax-free-childcare
